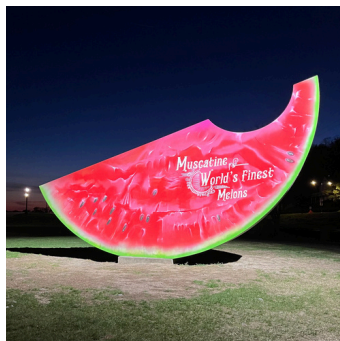




2023 YEAR IN REVIEW
